EMERGENCY CONTACT INFORMATION

Leaks may occur when a homeowner is not home or on vacation. Occasionally, someone may call to inform us that they see water coming from a property. If no one is home, our first step is to isolate the leak. A leak may require a partial shutdown (perhaps a valve on the irrigation system), or a full shut down (for a leak between the meter and the house). Our crews will always leave a door hanger and may leave a phone message at the customer's home.

We encourage our customers to give us contact information for cases such as these—a home number, cell number, or an email address. An email from us may be a quicker way for customers to find out about a leak instead of waiting until they get home from vacation. Please provide contact information by noting it on your stub the next time you pay your bill. You may also send in a note or give us a call.

Please be assured that any information you give us will be held strictly confidential and will never be given out to third parties.
